Named and designated scholarship/fellowship grant application process: (Note: these grants are only available to undergraduate or graduate Brothers of Zeta Chapter of Phi Gamma Delta.)

A single application may be considered for more than one grant. The applicant must designate the specific grant(s) being applied for with the application. The name of the grant(s) must be noted in the appropriate section on page 1 of the application. Applications without such designation will not be considered.

NOTE: WHY DID THE BEF DESIGNATE THE AWARDS? The special interest designations reflect the named Brother(s) interest and/or participation during their undergraduate years at Zeta Chapter and/or special areas of interest regarding Indiana University or Zeta Chapter following their graduation. The continuation of excellence by Zeta Chapter and IU is a common thread for each grant.

<u>NOTE</u>: ALL GRANTS ARE PAID DIRECTLY TO INDIANA UNIVERSITY (OR THE DESIGNATED SCHOOL FOR POST-GRADUATE STUDY) IN THE NAME OF THE GRANT RECIPIENT. IF, FOR ANY REASON, THE GRANT RECIPIENT FAILS TO ENROLL AS A FULL-TIME STUDENT AT THE SCHOOL WHERE THE GRANT IS SENT, THE GRANT WILL BE NULLIFIED AND THE FUNDS WILL BE RETURNED TO THE BEECHWOOD EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION.

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP ANNUAL GRANTS

Applicants must:

- (1) Be a member in good standing with Zeta Chapter of Phil Gamma Delta as confirmed by the Zeta Chapter Purple Legionnaire or his designee.
- (2) Have lived in the Zeta Chapter House ever since becoming a member of Phi Gamma Delta (Zeta Chapter) and be currently living in the Zeta Chapter House; exceptions include being married, having signed a year-long housing contract BEFORE pledging, or living at home in Bloomington.
- (3) Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and be enrolled as a full-time student.
- (4) Satisfy the UNIQUE requirement(s) for each specific grant for which the application is being submitted.
- (5) Have fulfilled all financial obligations to Zeta Chapter.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS FOR UNDERGRADUATES:

1) \$1,500 Grants

- a. Mark "Leon" Laesch Memorial Scholarship (1976) awarded annually in the second semester to a Junior in Zeta Chapter that, based on nomination by the Chapter Cabinet Officers, has best exemplified and promoted brotherhood within the undergraduate chapter while maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA and is active in the intramural sports program
- b. **Brock "Crocker" Gordon Memorial Scholarship** (1979) awarded annually in the second semester to a Junior in Zeta Chapter that, based on nomination by the Chapter Cabinet Officers, has characteristically built friendships inclusive of all ZETA FIJI members and has collectively made a high-level contribution to the Chapter's intramural sports program while also maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA
- c. The Jeff M. Fettig Family Scholarship (1979) awarded annually in the Fall semester to the current President of Zeta Chapter in recognition of his dedication to the Fraternity and leadership of Zeta's undergraduate chapter

2) \$1,000 Grants

- a. Harper B. Miller (Hap) (1929) must have served as a pledge class officer
- b. John E. Scott (1930) must be a member of a multi-member FIJI family (any chapters)
- c. **Eugene D. Fletchall** (1932) must have served on the IU Foundation as an undergraduate or served as the Cheney Cup chairman for Zeta Chapter
- d. **William F. Hillenbrand** (1944) must have participated on an IU athletic team or have participated on one or more Zeta Chapter IM sports teams
- e. **W. Anthony George (Tony)** (1949) must have served as the Zeta Chapter Philanthropy Committee Chairman for one or more years or the Zeta Chapter Campus Fund Raising Chairman
- f. **GEM Gustav and Emilie Mangels (Louis A. "Bud" Mangels 1956)** must have held a Zeta Chapter house job for one or more years, or have been a Little 500 rider, or have been a donor to the Phi Gamma Delta Educational Foundation or to The Beechwood Educational Foundation for one or more years
- g. **Frey Family** (James D. [1959]) must be planning a career in a health/health related profession (dentistry, medicine, medical/pharmaceutical research or commercialization, etc.), held one or more Zeta Chapter officer/chairmanship roles, been a member of one or more campus organizations, and participated in multiple IM sports

3) \$500 Grants

- a. **Bierhaus Family** (Arthur J. [1914]; Robert V., Sr. [1922]; Edward G. [1926] and Robert V., Jr. [1954]) must have served as the Pig Dinner Chairman, Graduate Relations Chairman, or the Hoosier FIJI Chairman for at least one year
- b. **Ray W. Clark** (1914) must have served one or more years as a Pledge Educator and as the fraternity father for a Zeta Pledge
- c. **William H. Keck** (1941) must have served as the Zeta Chapter Rush Chairman, the Awareness Program Chairman or the Brotherhood Chairman for at least one year
- d. **Cusick Family** (A. Michael, Jr. [1955] and James A. [1959]) must have served one or more years as an elected campus leader
- e. **George M. Ginn** (1957) must have served as an elected Zeta Chapter officer for one or more years or served as an officer of the IU Student Athletic Board (SAB)
- f. **Heber D. Williams Family** (Heber D. [1920], Richard K., Sr. [1956] and Phillip A. [1983]) must be at least a second-generation Zeta FIJI and served as either Mom's Weekend Chairman, Dad's Weekend Chairman, or Zeta Chapter Rush Chairman
